Re: Spring 2016 10-day Census - Official Enrollment Data

Enclosed are official spring enrollment data as of the ten-day census. These tables and additional tables will be published on the Office of Institutional Research (OIR) website (http://www.oir.uic.edu/) along with other student data that currently includes interactive tables of fall enrollments as well as retention and graduation dashboards.

Below are a few highlights from the spring enrollment data.

Enrollment Trends

- Our total enrollment is 27,191 this spring, up by 2.2% from spring 2015 (26,613). By level, undergraduate enrollments are up 2.4%, graduate enrollments are flat (0%), professional school enrollments are up 4.9% and continuing education enrollments are up 19%.
- First-time professional enrollments increased from 6 last spring to 426 as a result of 317 M.D. and 102 D.M.D. entering students beginning in the spring this year.

Undergraduate Transfer Students

Undergraduate transfers are down 12.3% from last spring (872 vs. 765). Undergraduate transfers were also down in the fall by 8.7% (1,718 vs. 1,569).

Undergraduate Retention

➤ Of the 3,462 new first-time full-time freshmen in fall 2015 a total of 3,152 are enrolled this spring, for a retention rate of 91.1%. In comparison, the retention rate from fall 2014 to spring 2015 was 92.5%.
