Re: **Spring 2017- Official Enrollment Data**

Enclosed are official spring enrollment data as of the ten-day census. These tables and additional data will be published on the Office of Institutional Research (OIR) website: <http://www.oir.uic.edu/> along with interactive tables of enrollments, and retention/graduation rate dashboards.

Below are a few highlights from the spring enrollment data.

Enrollment Trends

- UIC's total spring 2017 enrollment is 27,137, down by 0.2% (54 students) from spring 2016 (27,191). By level, undergraduate enrollments are up 1.3%, graduate enrollments are down 4.8%, professional school enrollments are up 2.5% and continuing education enrollments are up 5.8%.
- Historically, our total spring enrollment is lower than total fall enrollment. The difference of 1,983 students in 2016-17 (29,120 in fall vs. 27,137 in spring) reflects an increase in attrition over the past recent years and is being evaluated.

Undergraduate Transfer Students

- Undergraduate transfers are down 9.2% from last spring (695 vs. 765). They were also down 12.3% last spring (765 vs. 872). In contrast, undergraduate transfers were up by 24.8% in fall 2016 compared to fall 2015 (1,958 vs. 1,569).

Undergraduate Retention

- Of the 3,307 new first-time full-time freshmen in fall 2016 a total of 2,987 are enrolled this spring, for a retention rate of 90.3%. In comparison, the retention rate from fall 2015 to spring 2016 was 91.1% and the retention rate from fall 2014 to spring 2015 was 92.5%.
