US NEWS & World Report 2019 Best Graduate Schools Rankings

The [2019 Best Graduate Schools](#) edition features information and rankings in business, law, education, engineering, medicine, social work, criminology, public affairs, sciences and nursing.

Not all programs are ranked every year, although the US News website presents the most recent rankings for every program, whether they were ranked in 2019 or not. Rankings include both public and private ranked schools. (There is more of a balance of public versus private institutions represented in the US News graduate program rankings: e.g. 12 of the top 25 Engineering schools are public; 15 of the top 25 Education schools are public; 13 of the top 25 Nursing schools are public, and 12 of the top 25 Chemistry programs are public.) Below are some of the UIC highlights:

- The Master's in Nursing program improved to 18th from 20th.
- Nursing DNP improved to 12th from 15th.
 - College of Nursing specialty programs in the top 20:
 - Nursing Administration ranks 4th
 - Nurse Practitioner, Psychiatric ranks 12th and
 - Nurse Practitioner, Family ranks 12th
 - Nurse Practitioner: Gerontology, Acute Care ranks 13th
- Public Affairs, Urban Policy is ranked 6th.
- Public Affairs, Local Government Management is ranked 14th.
- Part-time MBA program improved to 47th from 66th.
- College of Education program in Education Administration and Supervision remained at 14th.
- College of Education, overall, declined to 54th from 48th.
- College of Engineering declined to 65th from 63rd.
- Social Work is ranked 24th.
- College of Medicine (Research) remained at 52nd.
- College of Medicine (Primary Care) declined from 51st to 67th.
