Re: UIC's Graduation and Retention Rates

Graduation Rates

UIC's overall graduation rate improved compared to the previous cohort. Graduation rates also improved for African-American, Hispanic, Asian-American and White undergraduates, as well as for men and women. Despite these improvements, differences by race/ethnic groups remain, with lower rates for African-American and Hispanic undergraduates.

- The fall 2012 <u>overall</u> entering cohort six-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 59.4%. This is up from 56.6% for the fall 2011 cohort, and is near our highest rate of 59.7% for the fall 2008 and fall 2009 cohorts.
- The graduation rate improved for <u>Hispanic</u> undergraduates to 54.7%, up from 49.6% for the fall 2011 cohort, and similar to the level it was at for the fall 2008 through fall 2010 cohorts.
- The fall 2012 graduation rate for <u>African-American</u> undergraduates is 47.8%, up from 43.8% for the fall 2011 cohort, and higher than any recent cohort.
- <u>African-American</u> undergraduates are much more likely to drop-out with poor academic standing (34.9% vs. 22.3% overall). The same is true of Hispanic undergraduates but to a lesser degree (29.2%). Despite the gap, the percent of <u>African-American</u> undergraduates that drop-out with poor academic standing has been improving steadily for recent cohorts from 52.0% for the fall 2005 cohort.
- Our five-year graduation rate for the fall 2013 cohort of <u>transfers</u> is 75.8%. This is lower than the fall 2012 cohort (77.9%) and the fall 2011 cohort (76.4%).
- For the fall 2012 cohort, undergraduates entering the <u>College of Education</u> have the highest six-year graduation rate (71.9%), followed by the <u>College of Applied Health Sciences</u> (66.7%) and the <u>College of Engineering</u> (65.3%).

One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2017 cohort is 80.2%, slightly higher than the retention rate for the fall 2016 cohort (79.8%). The rate has hovered around 80% for recent cohorts, with a high of 81.5% for the fall 2014 cohort.

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- The rate held steady for <u>African-American</u> undergraduates (70.6% for the fall 2017 cohort as compared to 70.0% for the fall 2016 cohort). This is down from a high of 81.7% for the fall 2014 cohort.
- Undergraduates entering the <u>College of Engineering</u> have the highest retention rate, both for retention within their college (81.6%) and overall retention at UIC (88.8%).
