Re: UIC's Graduation and Retention Rates

Graduation Rates

UIC's overall graduation rate improved compared to the previous cohort. Graduation rates improved for Hispanic, Asian American and White undergraduates, as well as for women. Graduation rates decreased for African American and male students. Differences by race/ethnic groups remain, with lower rates for African American and Hispanic undergraduates.

- The fall 2013 overall entering cohort six-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 60.5%. This is up from 59.4% for the fall 2012 cohort and is our highest rate within the last 5 cohorts.
- The fall 2014 overall entering cohort five-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 59.3%. This is up from 56.2% for the fall 2013 cohort and is our highest five-year rate within the last 5 cohorts.
- The fall 2013 graduation rate improved for Hispanic undergraduates to 55.8%, up from 54.7% for the fall 2012 cohort, and slightly surpassing the level it was at for the fall 2009 through fall 2012 cohorts.
- The fall 2013 graduation rate for African American undergraduates is 46.2%, down from 47.8% for the fall 2012 cohort, however, still slightly higher than cohorts fall 2009 through fall 2011.
- African American undergraduates are much more likely to drop-out with poor academic standing (35.7% vs. 21.8% overall). The same is true of Hispanic undergraduates but to a lesser degree (27.3%). Despite the gap, the percent of African American undergraduates that drop-out with poor academic standing has been improving steadily for recent cohorts from 52.0% for the fall 2005 cohort.
- Our six-year graduation rate for the fall 2013 cohort of transfers is 76.9%, down from 78.3% for the fall 2012 cohort. For the fall 2013 cohort, undergraduates entering the College of Applied Health Sciences have the highest six-year graduation rate (75%), followed by the College of Education (70.3%) and the College of Engineering (62.3%).

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One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2018 cohort is 79.2%, slightly lower than the retention rate for the fall 2017 cohort (80.2%). The rate has hovered around 80% for recent cohorts, with a high of 81.5% for the fall 2014 cohort.

- The rate held steady for African American undergraduates (70.8% for the fall 2018 cohort as compared to 70.6% for the fall 2017 cohort). This is down from a high of 81.7% for the fall 2014 cohort.
- Undergraduates entering the College of Engineering have the highest retention rate, both for retention within their college (85.7%) and overall retention at UIC (89.8%).
