# Re: Spring 2019 Ten-day Census – Official Enrollment Data (Initial Release)

Enclosed (attached) are official spring enrollment data as of the ten-day census. These tables and additional data will be published on the Office of Institutional Research (OIR) website: <u>http://www.oir.uic.edu/</u> along with interactive tables of enrollments and retention rates.

Below are a few highlights from the spring enrollment data.

## **Enrollment Trends**

- ➢ UIC's total spring 2019 enrollment is 29,596, up by 3.0% (+871 students) from the spring 2018 enrollment of 28,725.
- Historically, our total spring enrollment is lower than our total fall enrollment. The difference in spring 2019 enrollments (29,596) as compared to fall 2018 (31,683) is -6.6% (-2,087). The fall to spring percentage difference has ranged from -4.5% to -6.8% over the last nine years and the enrollment count difference has ranged from -1,260 to -2,087. There are many student flow factors influencing this pattern of lower spring enrollments compared to fall. Some of those are captured in the trends by student level and student type. Additional factors include students' graduating and student attrition/retention.
- A total of 2,013 students graduated in December 2018: 1,247 were undergraduates and 766 were graduate or professional students. This number of total graduates is higher than December 2017 (1,902) by 111 students.
- There are 719 UIC global students enrolled in spring 2019, and there are 27 UIC global students among the 79 new first-time freshmen this spring. This is almost double the number of UIC global students enrolled in spring 2018 (371).
- Compared to last spring by student level, undergraduate enrollments are up 6.2% (+1,112), graduate enrollments are down -3.7% (-259), professional school enrollments are up 0.8% (+25) and continuing education enrollments are down -1.1% (-7). This overall pattern in spring enrollments is similar to the pattern of enrollments this fall. Overall enrollment growth is driven by significant growth in undergraduate enrollments accompanied by a small increase in professional school enrollments and a decrease in graduate enrollments.

Compared to last spring by student type, continuing student enrollments are up 3.4% (+901), first-time graduate enrollments are down -20.1% (-78), first-time professional school enrollments are down -1.3% (-5), new first-time freshmen enrollments are up 11.3% (+8), new non-degree graduate enrollments are up 13.9% (+29), new non-degree undergraduate enrollments are up 32.5% (+38), and new transfer-in undergraduates are down -5.8% (-48).

### Undergraduate Retention

Of the 4,109 new first-time full-time freshmen in fall 2018 a total of 3,696 are enrolled this spring, for a retention rate of 89.9%. In comparison, the retention rate from fall 2017 to spring 2018 was 90.7% and the retention rate from fall 2016 to spring 2017 was 90.3%.
