Re: Spring 2021 Ten-day Census – Official Enrollment Data

Enclosed (attached) are official spring enrollment data as of the ten-day census. Below are a few highlights.

Enrollment Trends

- UIC's total spring 2021 enrollment is 31,432, up by 0.7% (+216 students) from the spring 2020 enrollment of 31,216.
- Historically, our total spring enrollment is lower than our total fall enrollment. The difference in spring 2021 enrollments (31,432) as compared to fall 2020 (33,518) is -6.2% (-2,086).
- The fall to spring percentage difference has ranged from -4.4% to -6.8% over the last dozen years and the enrollment count difference has ranged from -1,170 to -2,174. There are many student flow factors influencing the pattern of lower spring enrollments compared to fall. Some of those factors are seen in the trends by student level and student type, as well as the trends in students' graduating and student attrition/retention.
- Compared to last spring by student level, undergraduate enrollments are up 0.2% (+48), graduate enrollments are up 1.4% (+102), and professional school enrollments are up 1.6% (+66).
- The overall annual increase in spring enrollments (spring to spring) is similar to the pattern in the fall (up 0.4% in fall 2020 and up 0.7% in spring 2021).
- The annual increase in undergraduate enrollments was lower in the spring compared to the fall (up 1.3% in fall 2020 and up 0.2% in spring 2021). This was partly driven by lower new first-time transfers this spring (down 15.3%, see also below).
- ➢ Graduate enrollments are up 1.4% this spring compared to a decline of 1.7% in the fall. This was partly driven by an increase of 56.8% (+200) in first-time graduate student this spring.
- ▶ Professional school enrollments are up 1.6%, compared to the 0.5% decrease in fall 2020.
- For undergraduate enrollments, compared to last spring by student type, continuing student enrollments are up 0.9% (+176), first-time full-time first-years (freshmen) enrollments are down 2.4% (-2), and new transfers-in undergraduates are down -15.3% (-118).

- There are 1,055 UIC Global students enrolled in spring 2021, and there are 32 UIC Global students among the 84 new first-time first-years (freshmen) this spring. This is an increase of 70 students compared to UIC Global students enrolled in spring 2020 (985), and an increase of four new first-time first-years (28 in spring 2020).
- A total of 2,084 students graduated in December 2020, of which 1,344 were undergraduates and 740 were graduate and professional students. In comparison to December 2019, the number of total graduates is higher (2,084 vs. 2,052), the number of undergraduates graduating is higher (1,344 vs. 1,291), and the number of graduate and professional students graduating is lower (740 vs. 759).

Undergraduate Retention

Of the 3,457 new first-time full-time first-years (freshmen) in fall 2020 a total of 3,111 are enrolled this spring, for a retention rate of 90.0%. In comparison, the retention rate from fall 2019 to spring 2020 was 91.8%, and the retention rate from fall 2018 to spring 2019 was 89.9%. The highest fall to spring retention rate in recent years was for the fall 2014 new first-time full-time first-years, with a spring retention rate of 92.5%.
