Re: UIC's Graduation and Retention Rates

Introduction

Enclosed (attached) are the official graduation and retention rates for undergraduates updated with rates for the most recently available cohorts. Below is a brief summary of graduation rates and retention rates. Summary of Graduation Rates

UIC's overall six-year graduation rate for the fall 2015 entering cohort is 62.3%, a decrease of 1.2 percentage point when compared to the fall 2014 entering cohort (63.5%).

Six-year graduation rates improved for both the Asian (73.7%, up from 72.5%) and White (66.5%, up from 65.6%) fall 2015 entering cohorts compared to the fall 2014 entering cohorts; however, they decreased for both Black/African American (51.6%, down from 54.2%) and Hispanic (54.0%, down from 57.5%). The gap in six-year graduation rates for Blacks compared to the overall rate has risen to 10.7 percentage points (51.6% vs. 62.3%). The gap in six-year graduate rates for Hispanics compared to overall rates has risen to 8.3 percentage points (54.0% vs. 62.3%). Gender gaps remain, but the graduation rate for men held steady (60.6%, down slightly from 60.8%) while the graduation rate for women decreased by 2 percentage points (63.8%, down from 65.8%).

Other highlights of the newly released graduation rates include:

• The fall 2016 overall entering cohort five-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 57.8%. This is slightly up from 57.3% for the fall 2015 cohort.

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- The fall 2017 overall entering cohort four-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 39.7%. This is about the same as the fall 2016 cohort, 39.6%.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2015 cohort of <u>transfers</u> is 78.5%, down from 79.2% for the fall 2014 transfer cohort.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2015 cohort for Pell recipients is 60.8% and 64.3% for non-Pell, a 3.5 percentage point gap. The gap was similar for the fall 2014 (3.7 percentage points) and fall 2013 (3.4 percentage points) cohorts. The gap was 6.4 percentage points for the fall 2011 cohort, thus the gap has narrowed in recent years.
- For the fall 2015 full-time, first-time entering cohort, undergraduates entering the College of Applied Health Sciences have the highest six-year graduation rate from UIC (69.3%), followed by the College of Engineering (67.3%).

Summary One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2020 entering cohort is 81.3%, down 0.9 percentage points from the retention rate for the fall 2019 entering cohort (82.2%).

- The retention rate decreased by 1.3 percentage points for Asians (91.0%, down from 92.3%).
- The retention rate decreased by 1.0 percentage point for Blacks/African Americans (75.2%, down from 76.2%).
- The retention rate decreased by 2.3 percentage points for Hispanics (75.3%, down from 77.6%).
- The international student retention rate increased by 1.2 percentage points (86.3% down from 85.1%).
- The retention rate increased by 1.9 percentage points for White students (84.9%, up from 83.0%).
- For the fall 2020 entering cohort, the College of Urban Planning and Public Affairs entering students have the highest retention rate (90.0%) followed by the College of Education entering students (89.6%).
- The College of Engineering entering students have the highest retention rate within a college (82.3% retained in the college).
- The fall 2020 entering cohort retention rate for students who were awarded Pell is 1.6 percentage points higher than the non-Pell retention rate (82.0% for Pell, 80.4% non-Pell).
