Re: Fall 2022 Ten-day Census – Official Enrollment Data

Enclosed are UIC's official fall enrollment data as of the tenth-day census. Total enrollment decreased from 34,199 (2021) to 33,747 (2022), a decrease of 1.3% or 452 headcount. Enrollment is 1.1% higher than pre-pandemic levels in Fall 2019.

Undergraduate enrollment decreased from 22,279 (2021) to 21,807 (2022), a decrease of 2.1% or 472 headcount.

- The number of first-year undergraduates increased by 1.6% or 67 headcount, from 4,177 (2021) to 4,244 (2022).
- Continuing undergraduates decreased by 2.1% or 325 headcount, from 15,337 (2021) to 15,012 (2022).
- The number of new transfers decreased by 6% or 134 headcount, from 2,244 (2021) to 2,110 (2022). It is the sixth consecutive year with greater than 2,000 new transfer students.
- First time transfers experienced a moderate spike in the first year of the pandemic from 2,069 (2019) to 2,319 (2020), increasing by 250 headcount or 12.1%. In the same year new first-year undergraduates experienced a significant decline from 4,407 to 3,541 or 866 headcount – a decrease of 19.7%. This combination of a temporary decrease in first year undergraduates and increase in new transfer students is a contributing factor in the current decline of the continuing undergraduate population.

Graduate student enrollment increased from 7,697 (2021) to 7,798 (2022), an increase of 1.3% or 101 headcount. This is the second consecutive year of overall graduate enrollment increases, and the highest level of graduate enrollment since 2017. First time graduates decreased from 2,504 (2021) to 2,084 (2022), a decrease of 16.8% or 420 headcount. Continuing graduate students increased from 4,893 (2021) to 5,399 (2022) an increase of 10.3% or 506 headcount. The pandemic had a significant impact on graduate enrollments. In the first year of the pandemic new graduates decreased by 223 headcount

as students opted to defer their admission. This subsequently contributed to a spike in first time graduates in 2021, with an increase of 494 headcount or a 24.6% increase. In comparison to 2020, first time graduates for 2022 are up 3.7%.

Professional student enrollment declined, from 4,223 (2021) to 4,142 (2022), a decrease of 1.9% or 81 headcount. Enrollment is nearly equal to pre-pandemic levels. In fall 2019, the total headcount was 4,146.

Total international student enrollment increased by 9.6% or 373 headcount, from 3,890 (2021) to 4,263 (2022). UIC Global enrollment increased from 1,343 (2021) to 1,428 (2022), an increase of 6.3% or 85 headcount. Graduate students increased by 58 headcount and undergraduate students by 27 headcount.

Enrollment in UIC fully online programs increased from 1,220 (2021) to 1,434 (2022), an increase of 17.5% or 214 headcount.

Table 1 shows trends in UIC enrollments by student level. Table 2 has enrollment trends by student level by college. Table 3 shows race and ethnicity for the total campus. Table 4 shows undergraduate student enrollments by race and ethnicity. Tables 5 and 6 show graduate and professional students by race and ethnicity. Table 7 has that data for new first-years and table 8 includes new transfer students. Tables 9 summarizes new and continuing students by student types and table 10 does the same by college. Table 11 shows online programs only by college and student level, and Table 12 shows international student headcount by student level and college. Table 13 provide additional details for all students by level; Table 14 does the same for entering first-year and new transfer students.

The Office of Institutional Research will provide a detailed enrollment presentation to the Dean's Council at the October meeting.
