## Re: Fall 2022 Graduation and Retention Rates

## Introduction

Enclosed are the official graduation and retention rates for undergraduates updated with rates for the most recently available cohorts. Below is a summary of graduation rates and retention rates. Additional analyses are available through the interactive graduation and retention rate dashboards found on the OIR website here (please note that the dashboards require you to enter your netid authentication to access them):

## Summary of Graduation Rates

UIC's overall six-year graduation rate for the fall 2016 entering cohort is 61.6\%, a decrease of 0.7 percent when compared to the fall 2015 entering cohort (62.3\%).

Six-year graduation rates improved for Black/African American (54.8\%, up from 51.6\%), International (67.8\%, up from 64.7\%), multi-Race (61.0\%, up from 53.8\%) and White (68\%, up from 66.5\%) fall 2016 entering cohorts compared to the fall 2015 entering cohorts; however, they decreased for both Asian (72.8\%, down from 73.7\%) and Hispanic/Latinx (52.3\%, down from $54.0 \%$ ). The gap in six-year graduation rates for Blacks compared to the overall rate has dropped to 6.8 percentage points ( $54.8 \%$ vs. $61.6 \%$ ) compared to 10.7 percentage points for last year. The gap in six-year graduate rates for Hispanics compared to overall rates has risen to 9.3 percentage points ( $52.3 \%$ vs. $61.6 \%$ ) compared to 8.3 percentage points for last year. Gender gaps remain, with the graduation rate for men decreasing by 2.3 percentage points ( $58.3 \%$, down from $60.6 \%$ ) while the graduation rate for women increased by 0.8 percentage points ( $64.6 \%$, up from 63.8\%).

Other highlights of the newly released graduation rates include:

- The fall 2017 overall entering cohort five-year graduation rate for full-time, firsttime freshmen is $55.9 \%$. This is down from $57.8 \%$ for the fall 2016 cohort.
- The fall 2018 overall entering cohort four-year graduation rate for full-time, firsttime freshmen is $41.7 \%$. This is up from $39.7 \%$ for the fall 2017 cohort. The fouryear graduation rate has been steadily increasing for the last seven cohorts, with a total increase of about 12 percentage points corresponding to a $40 \%$ rate increase since the 2011 cohort.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2016 cohort of transfers is $78.9 \%$, slightly up from $78.5 \%$ for the fall 2015 transfer cohort.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2016 cohort for Pell recipients is $58.2 \%$ and $66.3 \%$ for non-Pell, an 8.1 percentage point gap. The gap has significantly widened when compared to the fall 2015 cohort ( 3.5 percentage points).
- For the fall 2016 full-time, first-time entering cohort, undergraduates entering the College of Engineering have the highest six-year graduation rate from UIC (69.6\%), followed by the College of Applied Health Sciences (68.8\%\%). Architecture, Design, and the Arts had the lowest graduation rate at 55.6\%, and the largest year over year decline, but the graduation rate is still higher than the five year average of $54.8 \%$.
- The School of Public Health began admitting freshmen in Fall 2018, and will therefore begin to appear in the six year graduation tables in Fall 2024.


## Summary One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2021 entering cohort is $78.3 \%$, down 3 percentage points from the retention rate for the fall 2020 entering cohort (81.3\%).

- The retention rate decreased by 3 percentage points for Asians ( $88 \%$, down from 91\%).
- The retention rate increased by 0.9 percentage point for Blacks/African Americans (76.1\%, up from $75.2 \%$ ).
- The retention rate decreased by 2.9 percentage points for Hispanics (72.4\%, down from 75.3\%).
- The international student retention rate increased by 1.9 percentage points (88.1\%, up from 86.3\%).
- The retention rate decreased by 5.1 percentage points for White students (79.8\%, down from 84.9\%).
- For the fall 2021 entering cohort, the College of Urban Planning and Public Affairs entering students have the highest retention rate ( $86.2 \%$ ) followed by the College of Engineering entering students (81.7\%). The College of Education had the lowest retention rate at $67.5 \%$.
- The College of Engineering entering students also have the highest retention rate within a college ( $76 \%$ retained in the college), followed by Business ( $74.6 \%$ ).
- The fall 2021 entering cohort retention rate for students who were awarded Pell is 4.6 percentage points lower than the non-Pell retention rate ( $76.4 \%$ for Pell, 81\% non-Pell).
