Re: Fall 2023 Graduation and Retention Rates

Introduction

Enclosed are the official graduation and retention rates for undergraduates updated with rates for the most recently available cohorts. Below is a summary of graduation rates and retention rates. Additional data are available through OIR's interactive graduation and retention rate dashboards. Please note that the dashboards are only accessible to current faculty/staff who have completed UIC's FERPA training and will require login with your UIC NetID credentials. Vice Provost Nikos Varelas will conduct an in-depth retention presentation at the November Dean's Council.

Summary of Graduation Rates

UIC's overall six-year graduation rate for the fall 2017 entering cohort is 60.3%, a decrease of 1.3 percent when compared to the fall 2016 entering cohort (61.6%). The cohort size has increased by more than 30% over the last five years. Tables 3 through 7 below provide a five-year trend of data by various factors such as race, ethnicity, college, and Pell.

Six-year graduation rates increased for Asian (72.9%, up from 72.8%), Hispanic (52.9%, up from 52.3%), and International (72.4%, up from 67.8%) fall 2017 entering cohorts compared to the fall 2016 entering cohorts; however, they decreased for Black/African American (47.7%, down from 54.8%), Multi-Race (57.5%, down from 61.0%) and White (63.1%, down from 68%).

The gap in six-year graduation rates for the fall 2017 Hispanic cohort, compared to the overall rate, has decreased to 7.4 percentage points (52.9% vs. 60.3%) compared to 9.3 percentage points for last year. The gap in six-year graduation rates for the fall 2017 Black cohort, compared to the overall rate, has increased to 12.6 percentage points (47.7% vs. 60.3%) compared to 6.8 percentage points for last year. Gender gaps remain, with the graduation rate for the fall 2017 male cohort being 4.3 percentage points lower than the fall 2017 female cohort (58% vs. 62.3%).

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Other highlights of the newly released graduation rates include:

- The fall 2018 overall entering cohort five-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 57%. This is up from 55.9% for the fall 2017 cohort.
- The fall 2019 overall entering cohort four-year graduation rate for full-time, firsttime freshmen is 42.8%. This is up from 41.7% for the fall 2018 cohort and it is our highest rate on record. The four-year graduation rate has been steadily increasing for the last eight cohorts, with a total increase of about 13 percentage points corresponding to a 43% rate increase since the 2011 cohort.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2017 cohort for Pell recipients is 56.9% and 65.5% for non-Pell, an 8.6 percentage point gap. The gap has slightly widened when compared to the fall 2015 cohort (8.1 percentage points).
- For the fall 2016 full-time, first-time entering cohort, undergraduates entering the College of Engineering have the highest six-year graduation rate from UIC (70.1%), followed by the College of Urban Planning & Public Affairs (64.7%). The College of Education had the lowest graduation rate at 46.3%.
- The School of Public Health began admitting freshmen in Fall 2018 and will therefore begin to appear in the six-year graduation tables in Fall 2024.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2017 cohort of <u>transfers</u> is 78.4%, slightly decreased from 78.9% for the fall 2016 transfer cohort.

Summary One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2022 entering cohort is 78.4%, and increase of 0.1 percentage point from the retention rate for the fall 2021 entering cohort (78.3%).

- The retention rate decreased by 0.1 percentage point for Asian students (87.9%, down from 88%).
- The retention rate decreased by 6.2 percentage points for Black/African American students (69.9%, down from 76.1%).
- The retention rate decreased by 1.3 percentage points for Hispanic students (71.1%, down from 72.4%).
- The international student retention rate decreased by 1.0 percentage point (87.1%, down from 88.1%).
- The retention rate increased by 5.2 percentage points for White students (85%, up from 79.8%).
- For the fall 2022 entering cohort, the College of Architecture, Design, and the Arts entering students have the highest retention rate (82%) followed by the College of Engineering entering students (81.9%). The College of Urban Planning & Public Affairs had the lowest retention rate at 62.8%.
- The College of Architecture, Design, and the Arts entering students also have the highest retention rate within a college (77% retained in the same college), followed by Engineering (76.6%).



- The fall 2022 entering cohort retention rate for students who were awarded Pell is 9.8 percentage points lower than the non-Pell retention rate (74.1% for Pell, 83.9% non-Pell).
- The one-year retention rate for the fall 2022 cohort of <u>transfers</u> is 81.9%, slightly up from 81.7% for the fall 2021 transfer cohort.
