Re: Fall 2024 Ten-day Census – Official Enrollment Data

Enclosed are UIC's official fall enrollment data as of the tenth-day census. Total enrollment increased from 33,522 (2023) to 33,906 (2024), an increase of 1.1% or 384 headcount.

Undergraduate enrollment increased from 22,107 (2023) to 22,495 (2024), an increase of 1.8% or 388 headcount.

- The number of first-year undergraduates decreased by -4.9% or 228 headcount, from 4,647 (2023) to 4,419 (2024).
- Continuing undergraduates increased by 3.2% or 471 headcount, from 14,902 (2023) to 15,373 (2024).
- The number of new transfers increased by 4.4% or 89 headcount, from 2,041 (2023) to 2,130 (2024). It is the eighth consecutive year with greater than 2,000 new transfer students.
- The Better FAFSA rollout from the Department of Education had a material impact on the first year undergraduate cohort. Issues included multiple delays, subsets of students unable to access and/or complete the form, as well as large scale formula changes. A variety of offices will be analyzing the effects of these changes on UIC students over the coming academic year.

Graduate student enrollment decreased from 7,315 (2023) to 7,252 (2024), a decrease of -0.9% or 63 headcount. First time graduates increased from 2,067 (2023) to 2,097 (2024), an increase of 1.5% or 30 headcount. Continuing graduate students decreased from 4,940 (2023) to 4,829 (2024) a decrease of -2.2% or 111 headcount.

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Professional student enrollment increased, from 4,100 (2023) to 4,159 (2024), an increase of 1.4% or 59 headcount.

Total international student enrollment decreased by -0.2% or 7 headcount, from 4,196 (2023) to 4,189 (2024). Graduate students again saw the largest decrease of 119 headcount or -5.0%, while undergraduate international students increased by 97 headcount or 5.7%. Professional international students increased by 11.9% or 15 headcount.

Enrollment in UIC fully online programs increased from 1,488 (2023) to 1,601 (2024), an increase of 7.6% or 113 headcount.

Table 1 shows trends in UIC enrollments by student level. Table 2 has enrollment trends by student level by college. Table 3 shows race and ethnicity for the total campus. Table 4 shows undergraduate student enrollments by race and ethnicity. Tables 5 and 6 show graduate and professional students by race and ethnicity. Table 7 has that data for new first-years and table 8 includes new transfer students. Tables 9 summarizes new and continuing students by student types. Table 10 reflects Fall 2024 estimates of the MENA and expanded indigenous student populations, these are not currently official IPEDS designations and are provided for informational purposes only. Table 11 shows online programs only by college and student level, and Table 12 shows international student headcount by student level and college. Table 13 provide additional details for all students by level; Table 14 does the same for entering first-year and new transfer students.

The Office of Institutional Research will provide a detailed enrollment presentation in collaboration with the Office of Enrollment Management and the Office of the Vice Provost for Academic Programs and Effectiveness to the Dean's Council at the October meeting.
