Re: Fall 2024 Graduation and Retention Rates

<u>Introduction</u>

Enclosed are the official graduation and retention rates for undergraduates updated with rates for the most recently available cohorts. Below is a summary of graduation rates and retention rates. Additional data are available through OIR's interactive graduation and retention rate dashboards. Please note that the dashboards are only accessible to current faculty/staff who have completed UIC's FERPA training and will require login with your UIC NetID credentials. As per the Fall 2024 Enrollment memo there will be a joint presentation of the Office of Institutional Research, the Office of Enrollment Management and the Office of the Vice Provost for Academic Programs and Effectiveness.

Summary of Graduation Rates

UIC's overall six-year graduation rate for the fall 2018 entering cohort is 61.6%, an increase of 1.3 percentage points when compared to the fall 2017 entering cohort (60.3%). The entering cohort size has increased by more than 36% over the last five years. Tables 3 through 7 below provide a five-year trend of the six-year graduation rate by various factors such as race, ethnicity, college, and Pell.

Six-year graduation rates increased for Asian (76.6%, up from 72.9%), Black/African American (47.9%, up from 47.7%), Hispanic (53.8%, up from 52.9%), Multi-Race (58.2%, up from 57.5%) and White (66%, up from 63.1%) fall 2018 entering cohorts compared to the fall 2017 entering cohorts; however, they decreased for the International fall 2018 cohort (67.5%, down from 72.4%).

The gap in six-year graduation rates for the fall 2018 Black/African American cohort, compared to the overall rate, has increased to 13.7 percentage points (47.9% vs. 61.6%) compared to the 12.6 percentage point gap for last year. The gap in six-year graduation rates for the fall 2018

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Hispanic cohort, compared to the overall rate, has also slightly increased to 7.8 percentage points (53.8% vs. 61.6%) compared to 7.4 percentage point gap for last year. Gender gaps remain, with the graduation rate for the fall 2018 male cohort being 4.6 percentage points lower than the fall 2018 female cohort (63.7% vs. 59.1%).

Other highlights of the newly released graduation rates include:

- The fall 2019 overall entering cohort five-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 57.6%. This is slightly up from 57% for the fall 2018 cohort.
- The fall 2020 overall entering cohort four-year graduation rate for full-time, first-time freshmen is 43.3%. This is up from 42.8% for the fall 2019 cohort and it is our highest four-year graduation rate on record. The four-year graduation rate has been steadily increasing for the last nine cohorts, with a total increase of about 13.4 percentage points corresponding to a 45% rate increase since the 2011 cohort.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2018 cohort for Pell recipients is 59.4% and 64.4% for non-Pell, a 5-percentage point gap. The gap has decreased when compared to the fall 2017 cohort (8.6 percentage points).
- For the fall 2018 full-time, first-time entering cohort, undergraduates entering the College of Engineering have the highest six-year graduation rate from UIC (78.2%), followed by the College of Business Administration (63.2%).
- The School of Public Health began admitting freshmen in Fall 2018 and has now been included in the reports with their first six year graduating cohort. Their sixyear graduation rate was 60.9%.
- The six-year graduation rate for the fall 2018 cohort of <u>transfer students</u> is 80.8%. This is up from 78.4% for the fall 2017 transfer cohort and it is our highest six-year graduation rate on record.

Summary One-Year Retention Rates

UIC's one-year retention rate for the fall 2023 entering cohort is 80.2%, an increase of 1.8 percentage points from the retention rate for the fall 2022 entering cohort (78.4%).

- The retention rate increased by 2.6 percentage points for Asian students (90.5%, up from 87.9%).
- The retention rate increased by 4.4 percentage points for Black/African American students (74.3%, up from 69.9%).
- The retention rate increased by 1.4 percentage points for Hispanic students (72.5%, up from 71.1%).
- The international student retention rate increased by 0.5 percentage point (87.6%, up from 87.1%).
- The retention rate increased by 1 percentage point for White students (86%, up from 85%).



- For the fall 2023 entering cohort, the College of Engineering entering students have the highest retention rate (83.8%) followed by the School of Public Health (80%). The College of Applied Health Sciences had the lowest retention rate at 75.1%.
- The College of Engineering entering students also have the highest retention rate within a college (77.3% retained in the same college), followed by Business (73.3%).
- The fall 2023 entering cohort retention rate for students who were awarded Pell is 6.4 percentage points lower than the non-Pell retention rate (77.4% for Pell, 83.8% non-Pell). The gap has decreased when compared to the fall 2022 cohort (9.8 percentage points).
- The one-year retention rate for the fall 2023 cohort of <u>transfers</u> is 84.6%, up 2.7 percentage points from 81.9% for the fall 2022 transfer cohort.
