**Re: Spring 2025 Ten-day Census – Official Enrollment Data**

Enclosed are UIC's official spring enrollment data as of the tenth-day census. Both spring to spring comparisons and fall to spring retention figures show improvement to recent prior years. Below are highlights.

**Enrollment Trends**

- UIC's total spring 2025 enrollment is 31,872, an increase of 2.19% (684 students) from the spring 2024 enrollment of 31,188.
- Historically total spring enrollment is lower than total fall enrollment. The difference in spring 2025 enrollments (31,872) as compared to fall 2024 (33,906) is -6.0% (-2,034). The fall to spring total enrollment percentage difference has ranged from -4.4% to -7.5% over the last sixteen years and the enrollment count difference has ranged from -1,170 to -2,556.
- This spring attrition was lower than the total from spring 2024, improving from a decrease of 7% to a decrease of 6%.
- Compared to spring 2024 by student level, enrollments were up for all student levels. Undergraduate enrollments increased 2.98% (604), graduate enrollments increased 0.55% (38), and professional enrollments increased by 1.03% (42).
- The overall annual increase in spring enrollments (spring to spring) showed an improvement relative to the pattern in the fall (fall to fall). Fall 2024 enrollments increased by 1.1% across all levels compared to a 2.19% increase in spring 2025.
- The annual change in undergraduate enrollments was greater in the spring compared to the fall, with fall enrollment increasing by 1.8% compared to a 2.98% increase for spring.
- Graduate enrollments were down by -0.9% in fall 2024, but increased by 0.55% in spring 2025.
- Professional enrollments were up 1.4% in fall 2024 compared to an increase of 1.03% for spring 2025.
- For undergraduate enrollments, compared to last spring by student type, continuing student enrollments increased by 3.13% (603), while first-time first-year enrollments were down -45.83% (-66), and new first-time transfer enrollments decreased by -0.33% (-2).

- Enrollments by college are included in the attached table 3, and there are a variety of tables that include breakouts by race and ethnicity. This includes separate tables of undergraduate, graduate and professional students by student type.

### **Degrees Conferred in December**

- A total of 2,093 students graduated in December 2024, of which 1,398 were undergraduates, 617 were graduates and 78 professional students. Total graduations across all levels in December 2023 were 2,260 so the current totals represent a decrease of -167. Undergraduate graduations were down slightly from 1,451 in December 2023. Graduate and Professional graduations were down from a total of 809, a decrease of -114.

### **Undergraduate Retention Fall to Spring**

- The fall 2024 to spring 2025 retention rates for first-time full-time students was 92.5%. In comparison, the retention rate from fall 2023 to spring 2024 was 91.1% and the retention rate from fall 2022 to spring 2023 was 89.9%. The current fall to spring retention rate equals the highest level of retention over the last 10 years. Retention rates are included in the attachment table 9.
