Re: Fall 2015 10-day Census – Official Enrollment and Retention Data

Enclosed are the official fall enrollment data and one-year retention rates as of the ten-day census. Total enrollment (including Continuing Ed and Contract students) increased from 27,969 (2014) to 29,048 (2015) an increase of 3.9%. This is UIC's highest 10th day enrollment.

Below are highlights from this year's enrollment as of the 10-day census:

- Undergraduate enrollment increased from 16,707 (2014) to 17,511 (2015); an increase of 4.8%
- Graduate enrollment had a slight increase from 7,912 (2014) to 8,114 (2015); an increase of 2.6%
- New freshman increased from 3,030 (2014) to 3,485 (2015); an increase of 15%
- New transfer students decreased from 1,718 (2014) to 1,569 (2015); a decrease of 8.7%

The one-year retention rates are based on the full-time fall census cohort. Below are highlights from the one-year retention rates:

- One-year retention of new freshmen increased from 79.7% (2014) to 81.5% (2015)
- One-year retention of African American freshman students increased from 74.8% (2014) to 81.7% (2015)
- One-year retention of female students is higher than male students among freshmen (82.5% vs 80.3%); this finding is consistent among the transfer student population with female students having higher retention (88.9% vs 87.5%)

Please note, graduation rates and total degrees awarded will be released on September 23, 2015.
