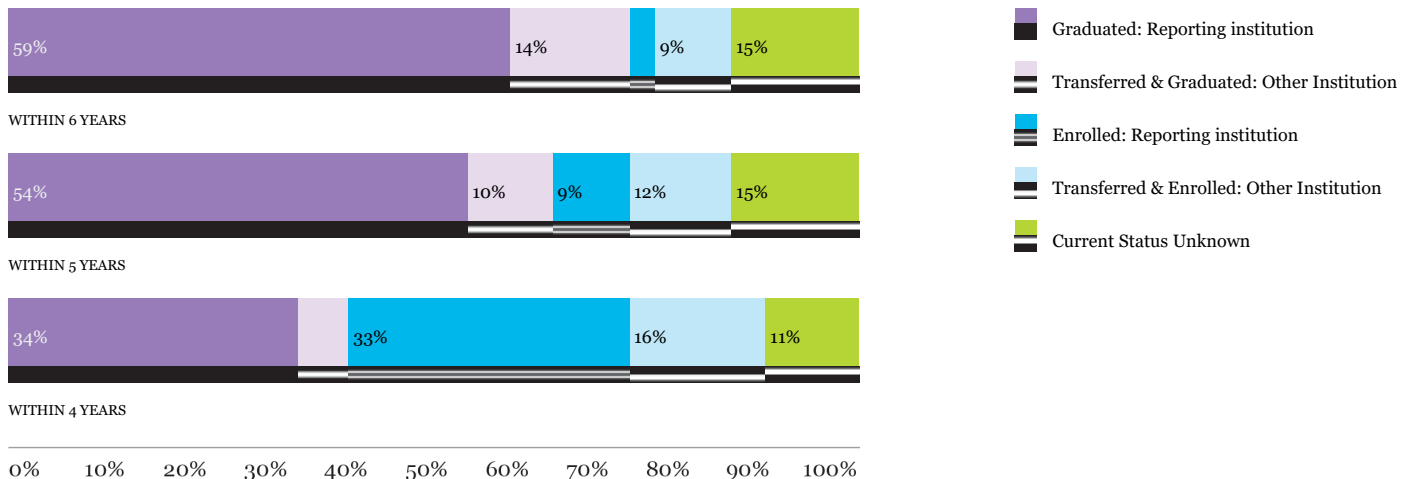

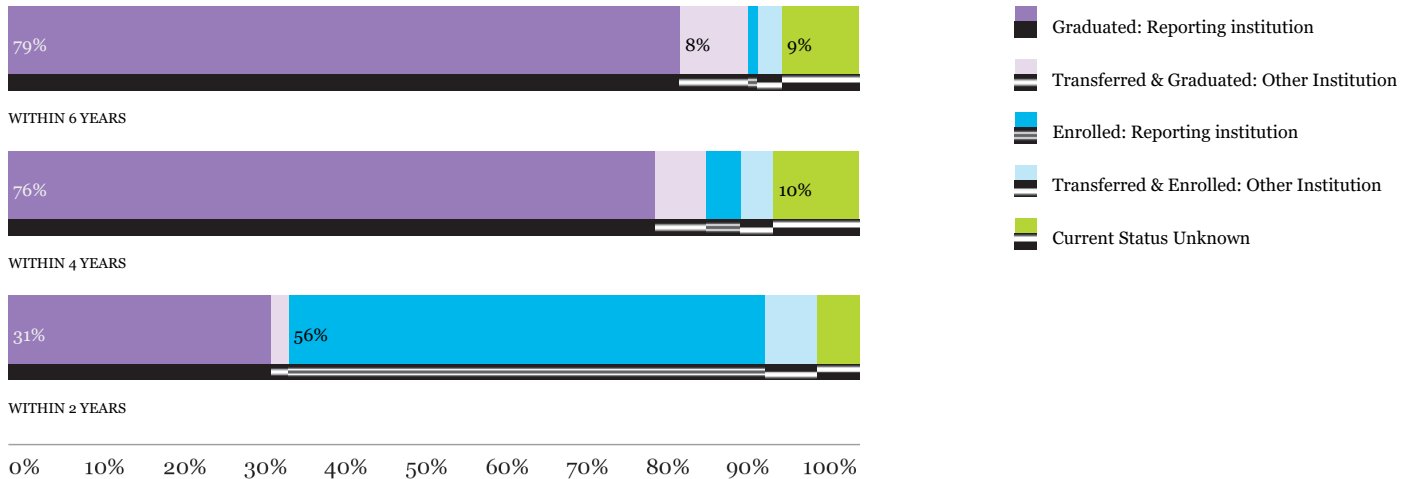
Full-Time Transfer
