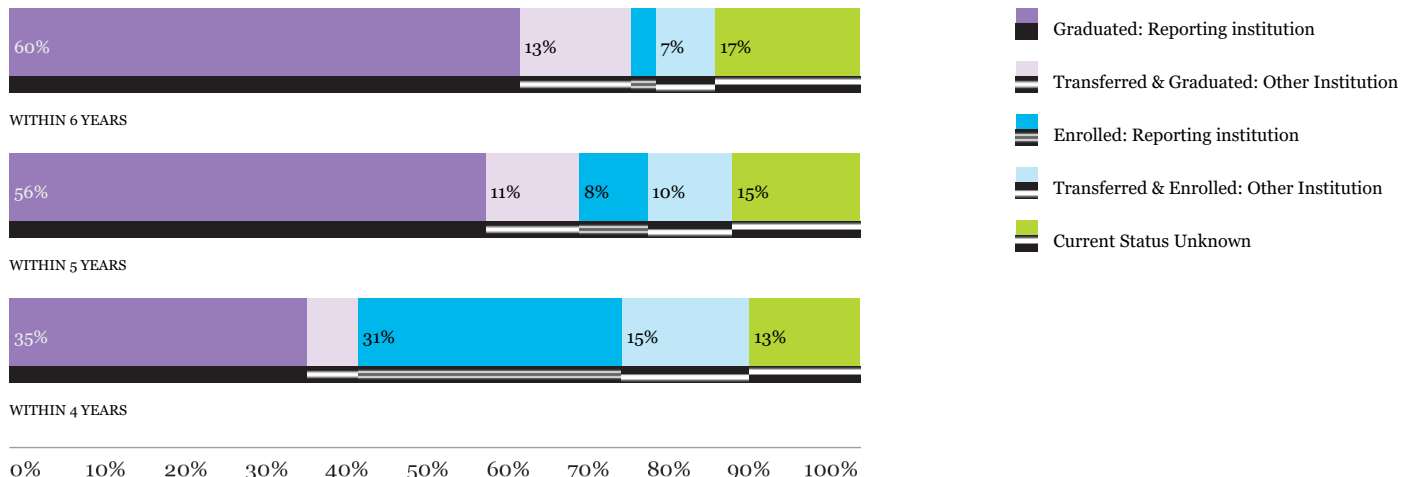

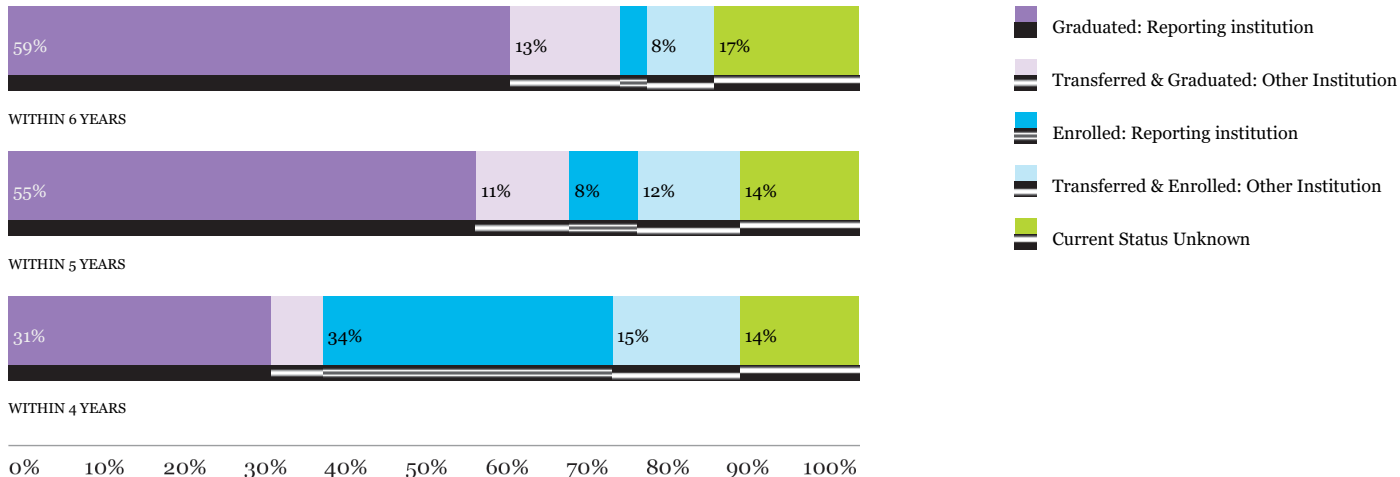

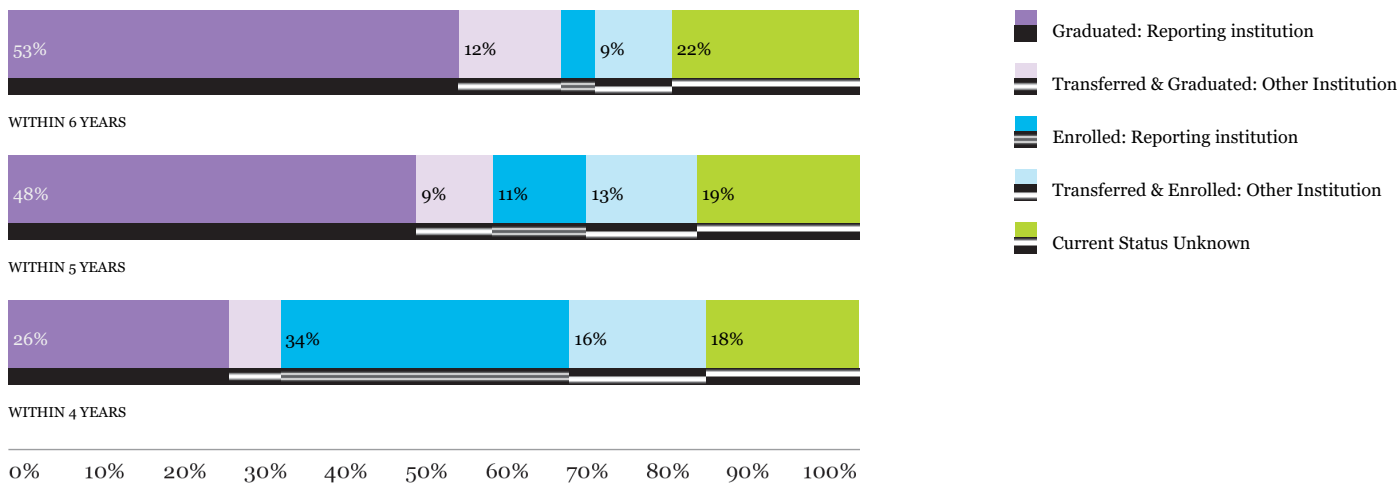

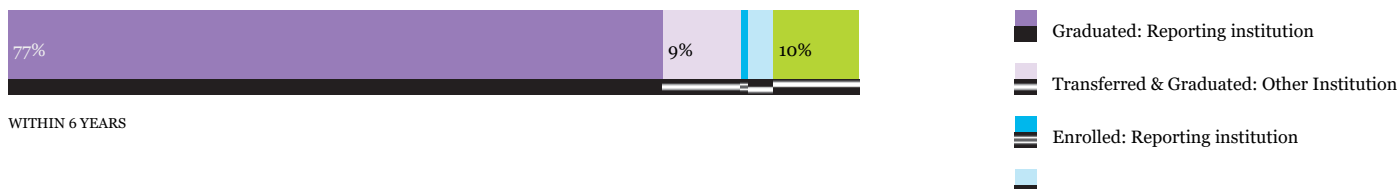

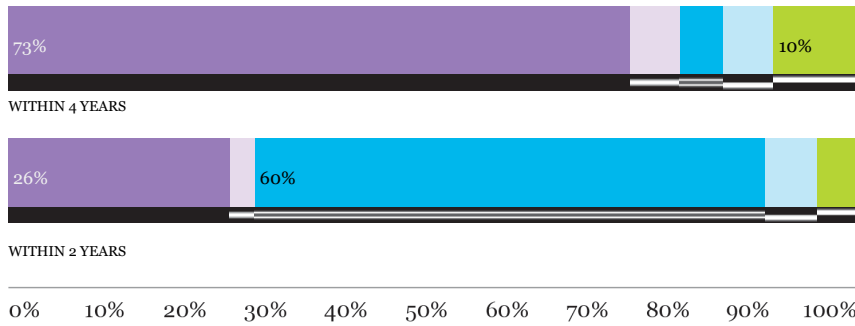


Full-Time Transfer Students Starting Fall 2013

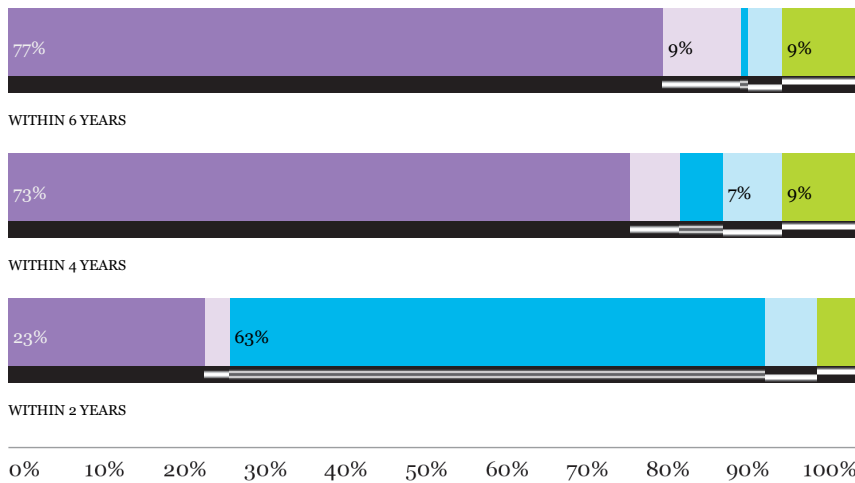

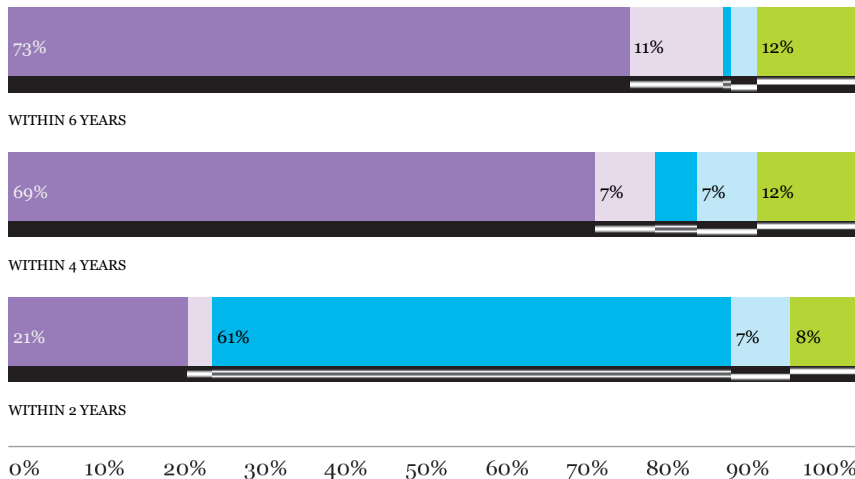

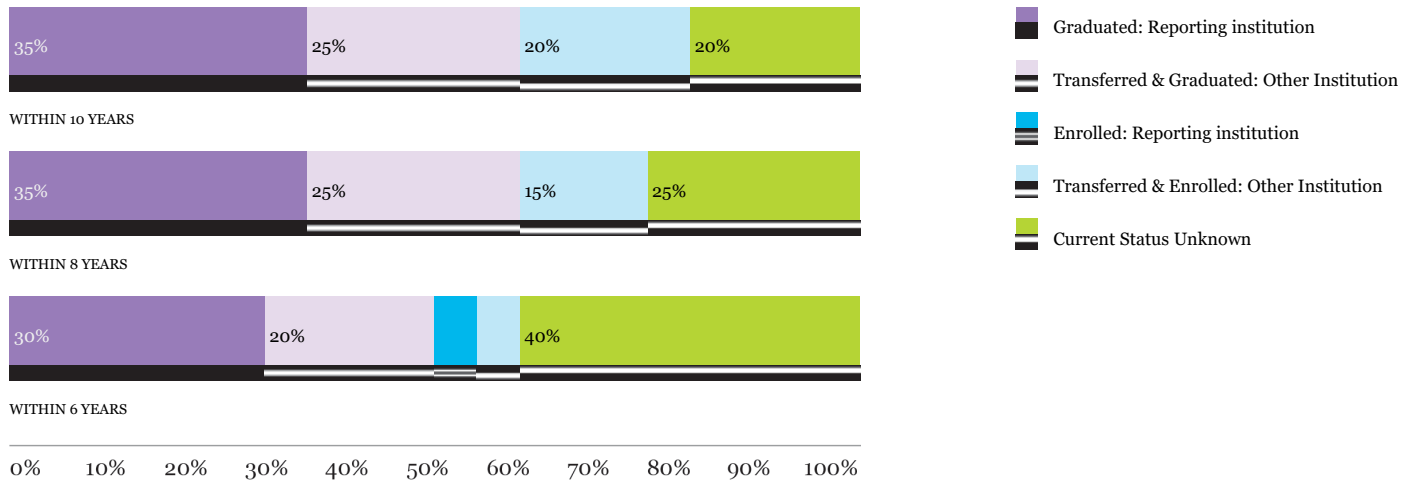
First-Time Part-Time

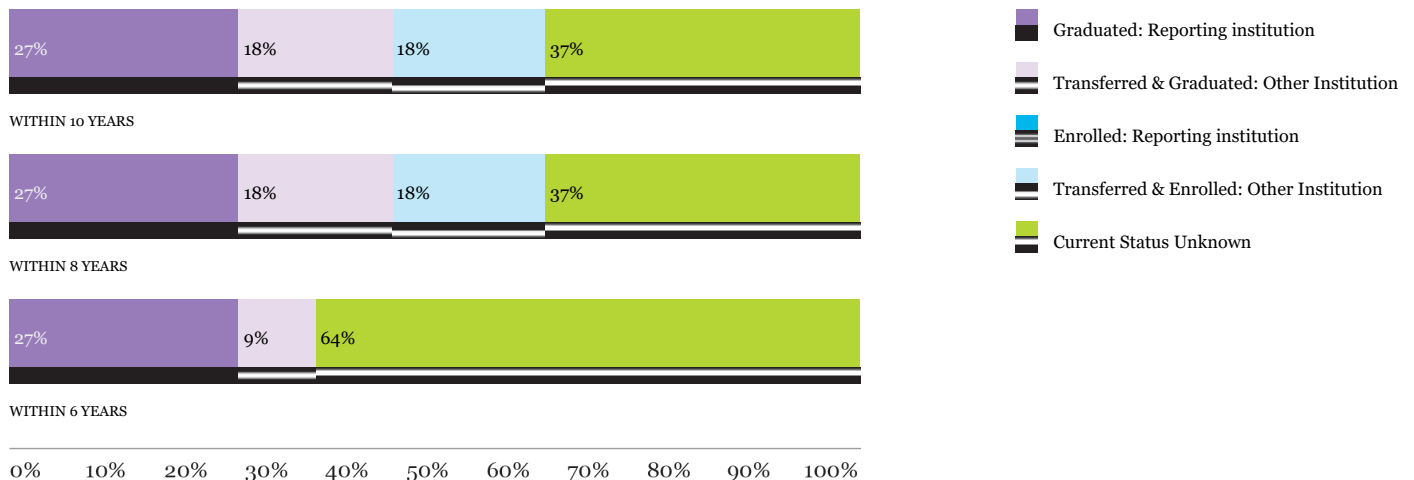

Part-Time Transfer

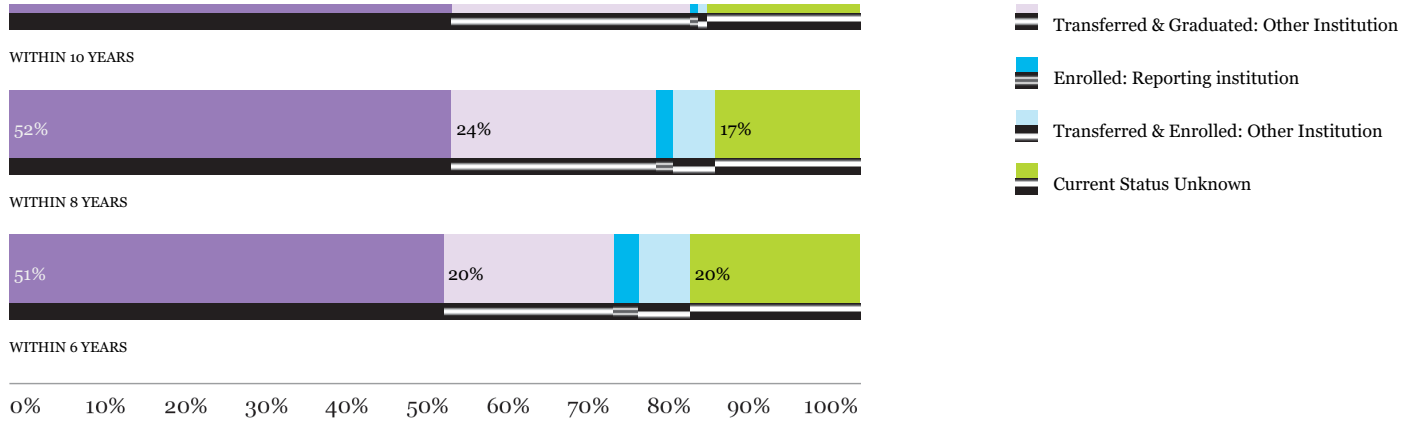


Part-Time Transfer Students Starting Fall 2009

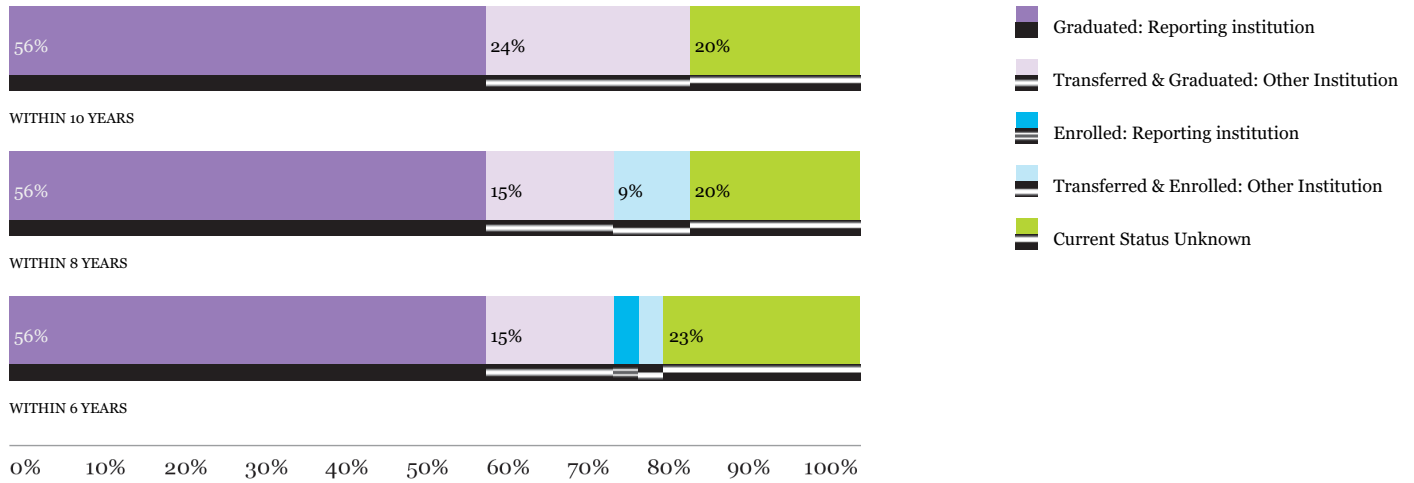

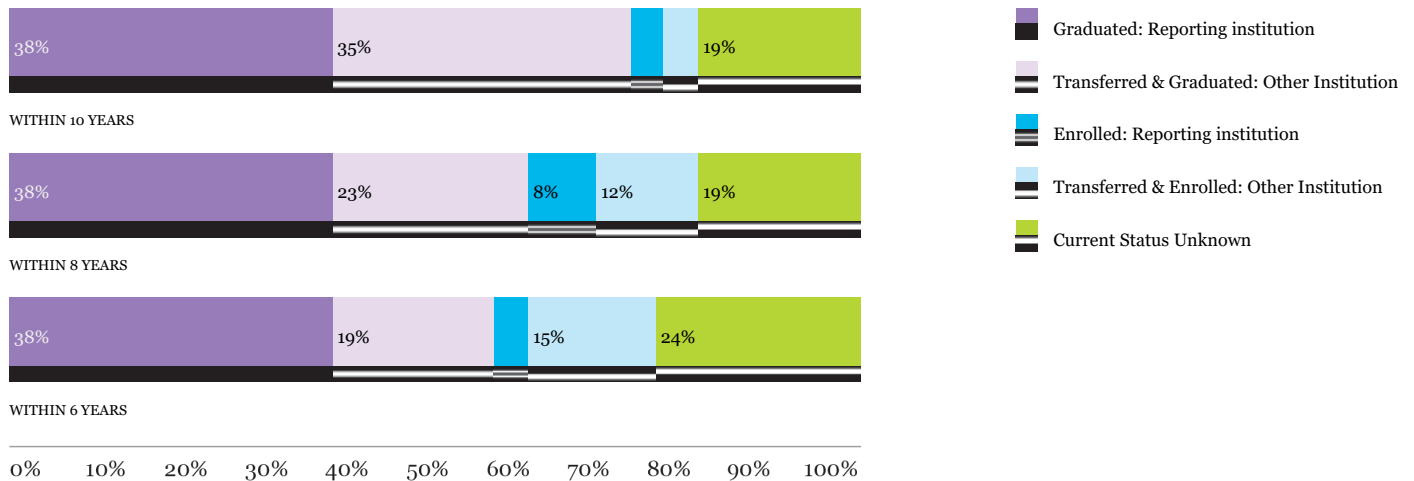
